On another level, the Placerville Art on Parade organization is hosting their successful "Banners On Parade" community art project. Look up to see these beautiful works of art along Main Street on the light poles and the Bell Tower.

The beautiful banners will debut on Main Street in June and be exhibited until mid- October when they will be for sale at a Silent Auction at the October 17th Art & Wine Festival.

And if that were not enough, there is a "grass roots" effort to beautify Main Street with hanging flower baskets on light poles and the Bell Tower in downtown Placerville. The Placerville Downtown Association is hosting a fundraiser on May 1st to help fund that project and is accepting sponsorships

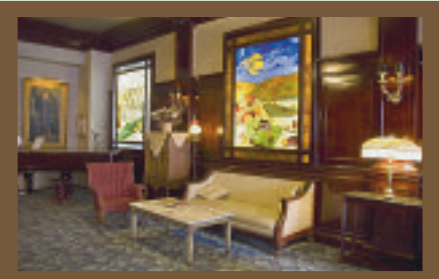

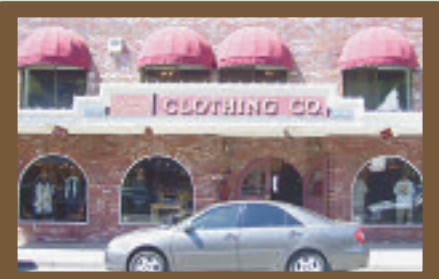

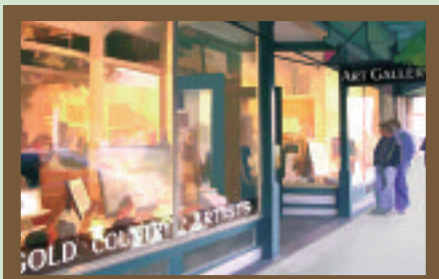
